How to set up Ask My Kid on Alexa?

Smartspeaker



1. Say "Enable My Kid". (Amazon might ask you for parental permission via the Alexa app)
2. Then say, "Alexa, ask my kid for..." (one of the phrases above)

Tablet/Phone



1. Download the Alexa app from Google or Apple.
2. Login with Amazon, search for "Ask My Kid" in skills, click Enable.
3. Then say, "Alexa, ask my kid for..."

Parent tip: Set reminders to keep up daily practice. e.g. "Alexa, set a daily reminder at 10am to ask my kid for addition"
